

Plan de estudios (Degree Plan)

- Fill out a Degree Plan (DP) with the courses to be taken to satisfy the degree requirements (30 MA credit hrs.) within their first semester.
- The Graduate Advisor (GA) will provide the form and instructions on how to fill this out.
- If any changes occur since you have filed your degree plan, you will need to send the GA the updated DP before you apply for graduation, preferably one semester earlier than your graduation.
- Students should keep a copy of their approved degree plan.


Degree plan for TAs/TFs

- TAs/TFs must enroll in nine (9) graduate hours every semester, except for the 4th semester
- Spanish MA: requires 30 SCH

- Domestic students: need to fill out a COURSE LOAD EXCEPTION (CLE) REQUEST in their 3rd semester important!

CLE Request Deadline:

"2-3 weeks before the start of each semester to ensure your request is processed on time." (TGS)

"International students do not need to submit a CLE form. Instead, submit the Graduate Part Time Enrollment Request from UNT-I for Visa purposes. CLE forms are not applicable to International Students". (TGS)




Teaching Assistant (TA) and Teaching Fellow (TF)

- ✓ Partial tuition waiver: Coverage for 3-6 credit hours
- ✓ Monthly salary (9 months)
- ✓ TAs (1st year students): weekly meetings; learn teaching fundamentals through TA supervisor guidance
- ✓ TFs (2nd year students): teaching experience;
 TF supervisor guidance



Plans of Study



❖ Non-thesis option:

- 30 hours (= 10 courses) of Spanish graduate coursework
- Pass 3 areas of comprehensive exams

Thesis option:

- 36 hours (30 hours of Spanish graduate coursework plus 6 hours of thesis credit)
- Maintain a 3.75 GPA in order to qualify to write a thesis
- Write a thesis and deliver an oral defense






EXAMS

Opción 1. Exámenes: Necesita completar 30 horas de crédito para esta opción:

- 30 créditos cursados dentro del Depto. de Español
- OjO: Cada clase se ofrece cada dos o tres años








- Los exámenes se basan en la materia cursada dentro del depto. de español y <u>la</u> <u>lista de lectura de la Maestría (pending an update)</u> (https://spanish.unt.edu/spanish-masters-program)
- Los estudiantes seleccionan 3 áreas de examen.
- Cada examen cubre un área de su selección.
- Es obligatorio haber tomado por lo menos un curso en cada una de ellas.








"Also, students will have taken at least ONE COURSE in each of the following areas regardless of the areas they choose in which to be examined:


- Latin America
- US Hispanic
- Spain
- Linguistics."



El semestre ANTES de tomar los exámenes es necesario:

- 1. Comunicarse con sus 3 profesores.
- 2. Luego escribir un correo electrónico a la *Grad Advisor* declarando sus 3 áreas.
- 3. NO hay cambios de áreas después.







- "Students must declare intent to take the MA exams the semester prior to the semester in which they are taking the exams.
- If students are planning on taking the exams in fall, they must declare intent during the previous spring. If a student intends to take the exams in spring, they must declare during the previous fall."







- Los exámenes se ofrecen cada semestre normal (i.e., primavera y otoño) durante la **5ta semana de su último semestre.**
- Se ofrecen en línea (Canvas) de 9 am -12 pm (3 hrs.), L, M, V
- Si se falla algún examen lo puede retomar la 8va semana del mismo semestre

O Esperar al próximo semestre normal.

 NECESITA UN 80% PARA APROBAR CADA EXAMEN.









- 1. En literatura-cultura, cada uno de los 3 profesores escribe un examen en su área con varias preguntas ensayísticas y el estudiante responde 2 (de 3 opciones).
- 2. En el área de lingüística,
 El estudiante escoge una (1) de 2
 preguntas de ensayo y contestará tres (3)
 (entre 4) preguntas breves de tipo
 analítico.
- No hay defensa oral para los exámenes.
- Hay que aprobar las 3 áreas en 2 intentos o menos.







Each area professor will write three (3) examination questions, of which the student answers two (2) to respond in essay format (length: about 500 words). The student will have three hours to answer both essay questions.

In the area of Linguistics, the student selects and writes one (1) out of two (2) essay questions, and also answers three (3) out of four shorter analytical sections."








"How is the exam graded?

Each essay question is valued at 50 points. The exam will be graded as a whole by the examining professor. Thus, both exam questions constitute one examination area; that is, 100 points.

In the area of Linguistics, an essay question is valued at 40 points, and each of three shorter analytical sections is valued at 20 points for a total of 100 points.

The exam will be graded as a whole. To pass the comprehensive exams students must earn an 80% or better in each exam."






If students do not pass one, two, or three exams, they may retake them during the 8th week of the same semester or during the regularly scheduled exam period of the 5th week of the immediately following semester.

A student who does not pass an exam on the second try, will be disqualified from completing the Master's degree."




Opción 2. Si opta por escribir una Tesis, necesita completar:

30 créditos cursados dentro del Depto. de Español + 6 créditos de tesis= 36 créditos


(at least 30 hours of course work must be completed in the major, i.e., Spanish)






Requisitos:

- **GPA de 3.75** (mínimo) al final de 18 créditos y debe de mantenerse a través de las 30 horas de créditos.
- Procurar director de tesis y 2 miembros.
 El director/a y uno de los miembros tienen que ser del depto. de español.
- Se escribe en español o en inglés.
- Hay defensa oral.



"Students with a GPA of 3.75 or better after completing 18 credit hours in all coursework at UNT

Important: a GPA of 3.75 must be maintained up to 30 credit hours, otherwise the student will be required to take the MA Exams."






- La estudiante deberá presentar a su director/a una propuesta de Tesis de 600 a 900 palabras con una bibliografía orientativa.
- La propuesta debe ser aprobada por los miembros del comité.







"Preparing the Thesis Proposal:

- Students must prepare a thesis proposal of between 600 and 900 words plus accompanying bibliography.
- The thesis director is responsible for submitting thesis proposals to the members of the student's MA thesis committee for approval.
- The student's thesis committee may provide comments on how to improve the proposal, suggestions by which the student must abide.
- The thesis committee has the final approval of all thesis proposals, and <u>forwards the approved version</u> <u>to the Graduate Advisor</u>.
- The thesis director and the graduate student are responsible for adhering to all Toulouse Graduate School guidelines and deadlines."





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"When is the Thesis proposal handed in?


Thesis proposals are written and handed in to the thesis chair and committee members during the semester in which the student declares the intent."


"MA Thesis Completion Timeline:

MA Theses are to be completed within three (3) semesters, during which students enroll officially as thesis credit hours. NOTE that the program allows for 6 thesis credit hours as part of meeting the 36 hour program requirement and no more.

If this timeline is not observed, students lose the privilege of continuing with the thesis option and must then complete the additional six (6) hours of coursework and take the comprehensive examinations as outlined above."

Thesis enrollment is required during every subsequent semester (and/or summer term if a faculty member is working with the student) until graduation.



"Students must have handed in to their Thesis Committee Chair and Members a final version of their thesis prior to the oral defense on or before the 6th week of the semester."


"The Thesis Committee Chair must approve the Thesis prior to setting up the Oral Defense.

The Thesis Committee Chair sets up the defense day and time in concert with the graduate student candidate."











La defensa oral dura una hora, y es pública. En los primeros 30 minutos la candidata hace una presentación Power Point con el argumento de su Tesis.

Luego hay preguntas del comité y del público.

Al final los miembros del comité hacen su fallo (¡A favor con toda suerte!)







Dates of the oral defense:

"It is highly recommended that the oral defense take place on a Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday thus allowing all members of the committee plus the graduate advisor to sign the required Pass/Fail form from Toulouse within 48 hours of the defense (to submit it to Toulouse in time)."

After the oral defense:

"Corrections to the thesis after the oral defense: submit the final version to the thesis director/committee first -→ then once approved, submit it by the eighth (8th) week to Toulouse (e.g., before the Spring break in Spring)."





Solicitar la graduación (filing/applying for graduation)

When do I file for graduation?

"IMPORTANT NOTE: Filing for graduation is a separate matter from taking the MA Exams and it takes place prior to passing the exams or defending the thesis."

Note from the Graduate Student Handbook

The window to file for graduation in Spring generally opens early October of the previous semester and closes mid-February.

It does not matter if students have successfully passed their MA exams or not in order to file your intent to graduate.



Graduation Requirements:

- Complete all Spanish coursework with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Pass the comprehensive examination or thesis defense.
- Satisfy all university requirements.
- All students must have an approved, current, official degree plan on file with the Toulouse Graduate School.


